



The Poetry Caravan of Columbia County

Who we are and what we do...

The Poetry Caravan of Columbia County is an off-shoot of the “original” Poetry Caravan which had its beginning in 2003 in Westchester County, and has been operating continually since.

The Caravan consists of a group of poets, all volunteers, who bring poetry (their own and others’) to audiences for whom poetry may not easily be available. At each scheduled program, two or more poets read poems appropriate to the audience. Participation by attendees is encouraged, since visits are not “performances”; rather they are the sharing of poetry.

The Poetry Caravan of Columbia County began readings at Camphill Ghent in March 2015, and shared poetry with the Canaan Historical Society, the Canaan Seniors, and Whittier Assisted Living. We are exploring other venues for one-time or regularly scheduled readings. The Roeliff Jansen Community Library is our sponsoring partner.
